

Some fun facts about Charlotte are that it is the largest metropolitan area in the United States without a zoo, Dairy Queen on Wilkinson Boulevard is designated as a national historic landmark. Registration is still open, and the cost is \$525.00 PI Convention 2025 | Pilot International Our early bird registration just ended and was well received with over 300 + people registering for the PI Convention. This year's convention includes: a dynamic opening night, workshops aimed at enhancing leadership skills and sparking innovative ideas, keynote speakers, PIFF Fundraiser at the NASCAR Hall of Fame, collaboration opportunities with Pilots and installations of officers to celebrate achievements and future plans. YOU won't want to miss these FABULOUS few days of events!

Pre-Convention Excursions are Monday July 21 and Tuesday July 22 ~ Tour to the Mall for \$35.00 or you can add Tree House Winery & Vineyard to your Tour of the Mall for a total of \$65.00. Polo Shirts are available with President Nicki's logo on them "No Pilot Left Behind" for \$30.00 and there is also a Pilot Convention Pin for \$5.00 (which everyone loves & they are great souvenirs to bring back to members that are unable to attend or gifts for new members.)

On the night of Installation Banquet there is a new approach to the beverage service. This year, we will transition from a traditional cash bar to a hotel-reserved wine table service. This change aims to enhance the banquet experience ~ no standing in line and managing costs effectively. So, make sure to order your wine prior to coming to the convention. You can find the selections and costs on the Pilot International Convention page and payment can be made by using Zeffy. (Which on a side note ~ PI has saved \$8,000 and counting by using this platform for all our registering)

Allen, Outstanding Community Service, Outstanding Pilot Club, Outstanding Pilot Club BrainMinder, Outstanding Pilot Club Visibility, Peral Sparks Service and Pick-Me-Up Project. The Awards Committee is ready and patiently waiting for all the submissions as we know there are so many worthy clubs, Pilots and projects. The deadline is **no later than 5 p.m**. on **May 15**th. All entries and required documents must be submitted in PDF format to clubservices@pilothq.org.

Please remember your registration is NOT complete until all 3 forms are emailed to Pilot Youth Development and Communications Specialist at youthdevelopment@pilothq.org Forms required are Anchor Summit Chaperones, Youth Release / Medical Forms and Photo Release. Anchors have several awards that are presented at convention also, however their deadline is a little earlier. It is **no later than April 15** and all entries and required documents must be submitted in PDF format to youthdevelpment@pilothq.org
